














MWRD'S LUCAS BERG SITE

The Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago's (MWRD) Lucas Berg Site is located on the south side of 111th Street between Oketo Avenue and Southwest Highway in Worth, Illinois. This 72-acre site includes several features that make it valuable for either commercial or recreational development, or a combination of both.

Situated at the intersection of 111th Street and Southwest Highway, the focal point of commercial development in the area, the property includes 13.72± acres with street frontage that are readily developable.

As a former quarry, the site includes 57.89± acres of submerged land that form two shallow lakes. Although not developable, the lakes could serve as an amenity to any development, including open space or recreational use.

The entire site, or one or more of the various subparcels, is available for purchase. This information packet contains site and cost details for each. Because MWRD is a local government agency, the sale of the property is subject to competitive bidding and approval by the MWRD Board of Commissioners.
