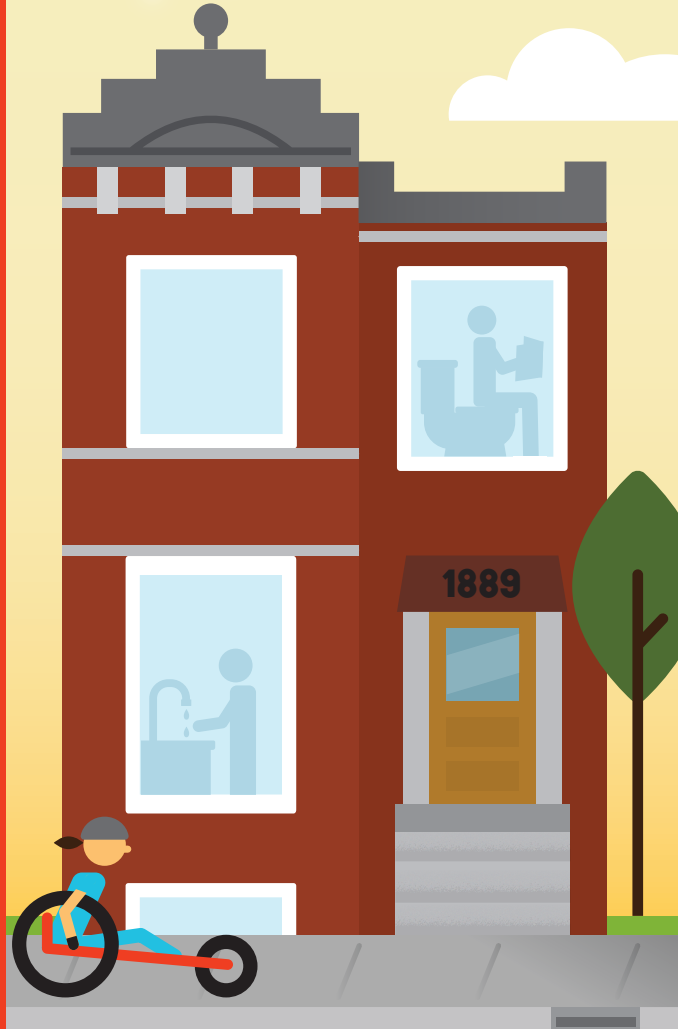


WHERE DOES IT GO?
